

INDIVIDUAL REFLECTION

- An explanation of how your puzzle is formatted to fit the theme “Parts to a Whole”.
- An analysis of how your puzzle is related to one or more of the biological processes we learned in Biology.
- An overview of how your puzzle fits in with the theme of your room based on the research you collected.
- A description of how your puzzle has evolved throughout the project based on feedback and trial and error. Please include some ideas of how your puzzle could have been made better if we were to do this project again.

Rubric:

Analysis	Student does not include any evidence or justification for their thoughts. It is a very flat response and does not prove they have reflected in a meaningful way.	Student only partially answers the prompts above, or only uses evidence for some of their thoughts. Perhaps more attention to detail would have improved their reflection.	Student answers the prompts above and provides justification and for their thoughts; however, the evidence used was weak, or did not help to strengthen their analysis.	Student writes a response that includes many pieces of evidence from many content classes and is very thorough while responding to the prompts above. Each section has justification and is detail oriented. The student has truly reflected on this experience.
Writing	Student has not followed proper writing conventions, and did not separate their thoughts by paragraph, or uses vague language which makes the response difficult to understand.	Student has many improvements to make in terms of spelling and grammatical errors. However their response is formatted correctly and is easy to follow.	Student has minor errors in spelling or grammar. The organization is easy to follow. Perhaps one more read through could have made this response more professional.	Student used proper punctuation, grammar, spelling and organization in order to respond to the prompts above. They followed the format, and had impeccable word choice along the way
